Ukolov's scientific school includes 15 doctors and more than 100 candidates of economic sciences, as well as monographs published on state, municipal, and corporate management, whose ideas have served as the basis for modern textbooks in Russia and abroad. He is a full member of the Academy of Informatization and Local Self-Government. Academician of the Academy of Local Self-Government and Social Technologies. He heads public international educational and commercial programs. He is an official consultant to federal government bodies on matters of state regulation of the economy and the social development of society. He has published over 300 scientific papers and is a laureate of the Russian Federation Government Prize in Education.
